Venue Hire and Servicing Fees

Half Day Hire: \$500

Full Day Hire: \$800

Evening and Weekend Hire: from \$950

Rates include exclusive space hire, access to available furniture and assets, administrative support and an onsite site visit. Additional site inspections may require additional fees.

Hire Period

The 'hire period' is 2 hours prior to the start time of the event and 1 hour post. Any set up and deliveries are to take place within your hire period. If the hire period needs to be extended to accommodate additional time for set up or equipment delivery, this can be negotiated with the Museums & Collections Events Team, and additional fees may be incurred.

Access

Please note that the grounds of University Square that surround MPavilion Parkville are managed by the City of Melbourne, and additional permits are required for any organised activity that spills over onto these grounds.

Loading to MPavilion Parkville is via Leicester Street, where cars may park and load equipment to the site via trolley. Please note there is no reserved parking available unless a permit is obtained by the City of Melbourne. A City of Melbourne permit is also required for vehicle access onto University Square.

Facilities

Please note there are no sanitary facilities at MPavilion Parkville or University Square. The closest sanitary facilities are located at the Alan Gilbert Building, 161 Barry St Carlton. These are accessible 7am-9pm on weekdays and 8.15am-5.45pm on weekends.

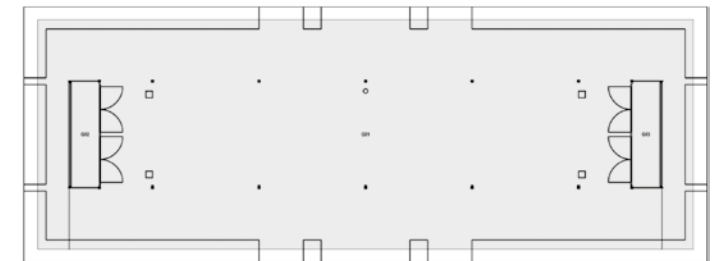
There is no running water available at the site.

As an outdoor venue, inclement weather should be considered when booking this venue. The structure has built-in blinds around the perimeter that can enclose the space. These will automatically retract in cases of high winds.
